About The Club

Lymm Angling Club has a wide variety of waters, all of which are actively managed. The club caters for specimen, pleasure and match anglers alike. The club encourages forward thinking, ethical, club minded angling. It has significantly fewer rules than many clubs however these rules are rigorously enforced.

Our membership year runs from 1st January to 31st December. Renewal must be paid by the 31st March each year to avoid paying a re-joining fee. Members can fish until 31st January on the previous year's membership.

Adult members may take their spouse or partner and up to two children or grandchildren (under the age of 16 years old) on their membership carry no extra charge however they must occupy the same peg.

In addition to EA rod licence rules the following rod restrictions apply:

Member +1 = 3 rods dawn till dusk then 2 rods maximum.

Member +2 = 3 rods

Member +3 = 3 rods

Night fishing is allowed on most waters. **There is no extra charge for night fishing.** Arrival slips and catch returns are compulsory on most waters.

Each water is managed by its own water keeper to ensure a high standard is maintained.

Note 1 – Senior members will need to purchase or earn an Estates Maintenance stamp (overstamp) if they wish to fish the waters marked with a * overleaf from **15th March to 15th June (inclusive)**.

Note 2 – Intermediate members may fish unaccompanied but must have parental/guardian consent to join the club.

Note 3 – Junior members on club waters must be accompanied by an adult of over 18 years of age, who will be responsible and answerable to the Committee for the safety and conduct of that junior.

Note 4 - Some waters are closed from 15th March to 15th June (inclusive) each year except to those Senior members who either complete a set amount of hours on approved work party tasks or who pay for the estate maintenance fee also referred to as an over stamp. An overstamp is included in Intermediate, Junior, Pensioner & Concessional classes of membership.

We trust this information gives you an insight and hope you join us and enjoy pleasant hours on our waters.

Note 5 - In order to support your application for a New or Renew Concessional membership please provided the evidence required that clearly shows you are currently in receipt of ESA, DLA, AA or have a blue badge or current award letter, we are unable to process your application until we've received the necessary proof.

Note 6 - Proof of age is now required with the purchase of the Intermediate fishing permit and parent/guardian to sign where indicated.
